What are RSS feeds?

RSS, which stands for Really Simple Syndication, provides you with a new way of keeping on top of S&P Global Market Intelligence (S&P) news. RSS allows you to view constantly updated headlines from S&P, in addition to headlines from other news publications, in one place. You can choose which feeds you would like to display.

How do I access the feeds?

You will need special software to access RSS feeds. RSS news readers allow you to view the service you select in one place and, by automatically retrieving updates, stay current with new content soon after it is published. There are many readers available and most are free. Some popular readers for articles include: [Feed Demon](#), [FeedReader](#), [My Yahoo!](#), [NewsGator](#) and [NewzCrawler](#).

After setting up your news reader, you will be ready to use S&P's RSS feeds. To subscribe to one or more feeds below, follow the instructions for your particular news reader.
