

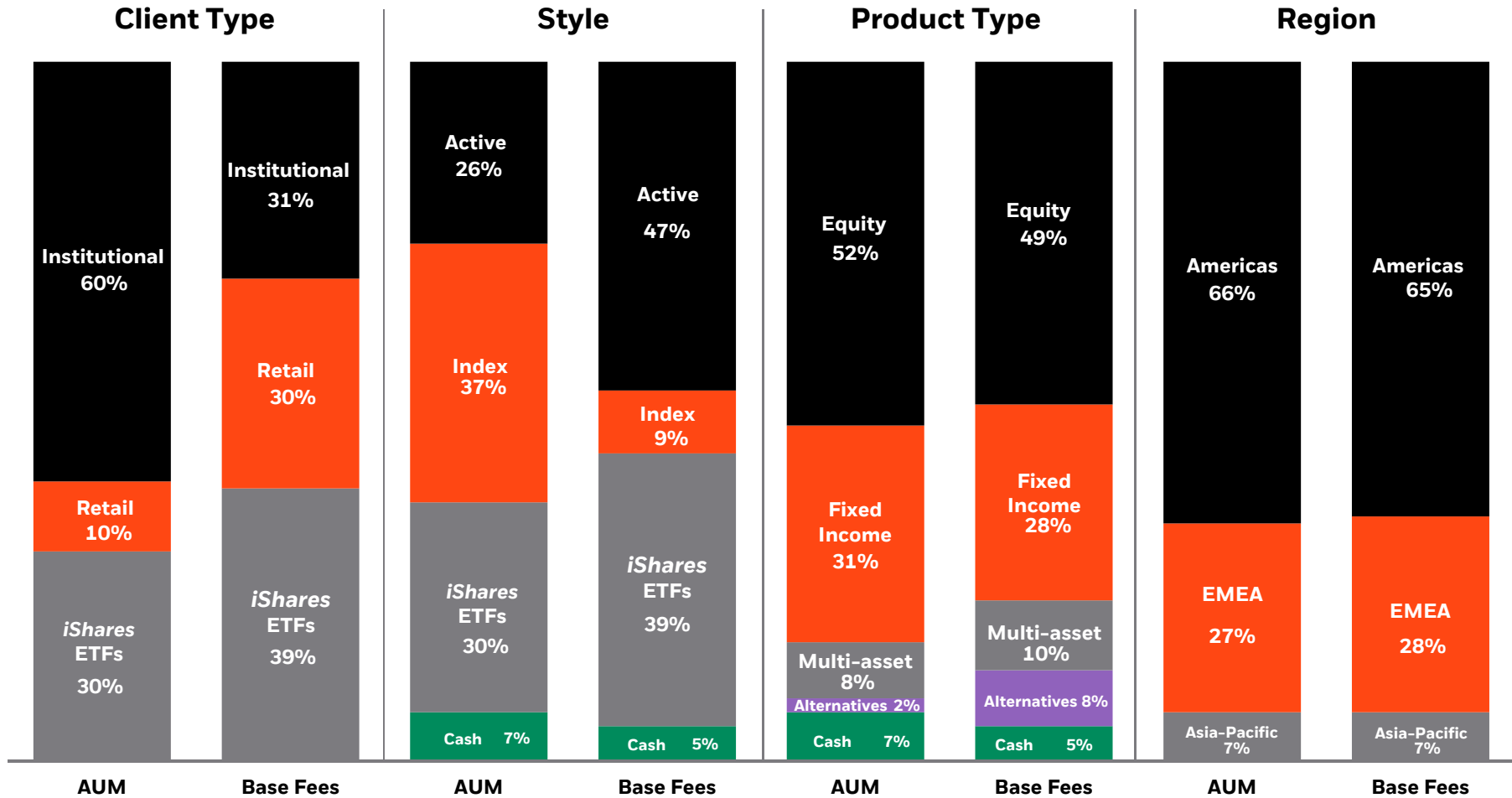

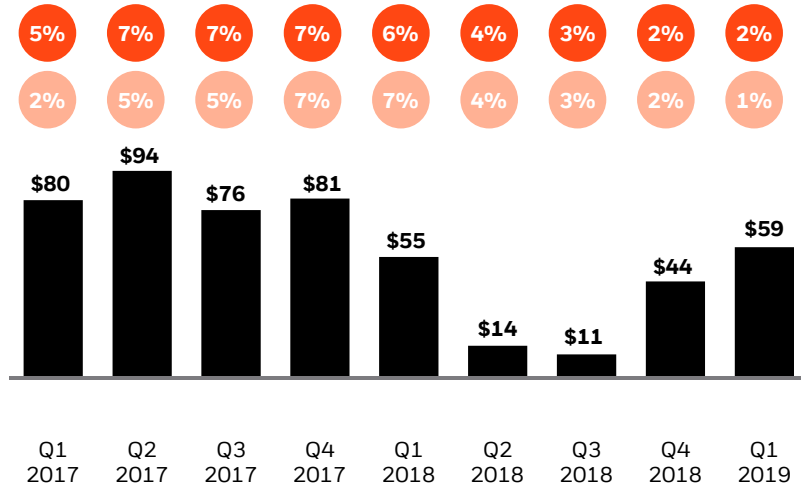
Assets Under Management of \$6.52 trillion at March 31, 2019  
Q1 2019 Total Base Fees of \$2.805 billion



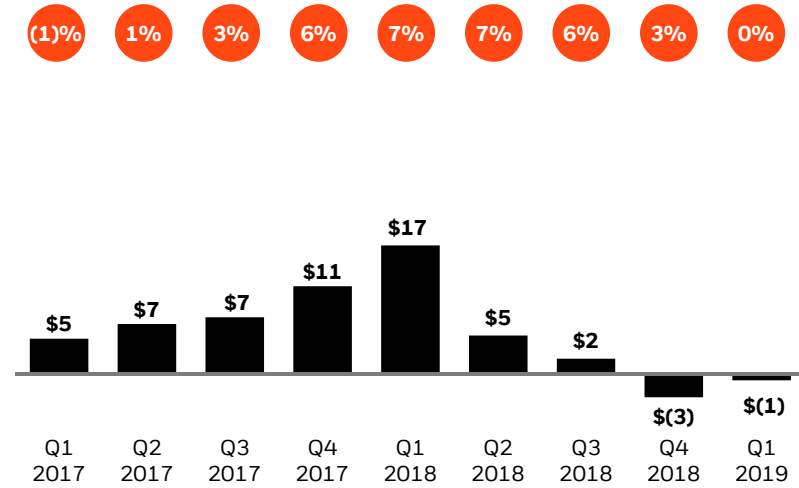

# Long-term net flows (\$ in billions)

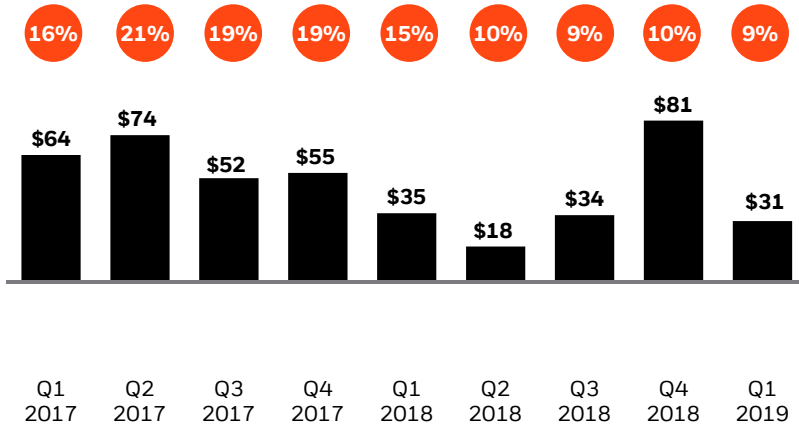

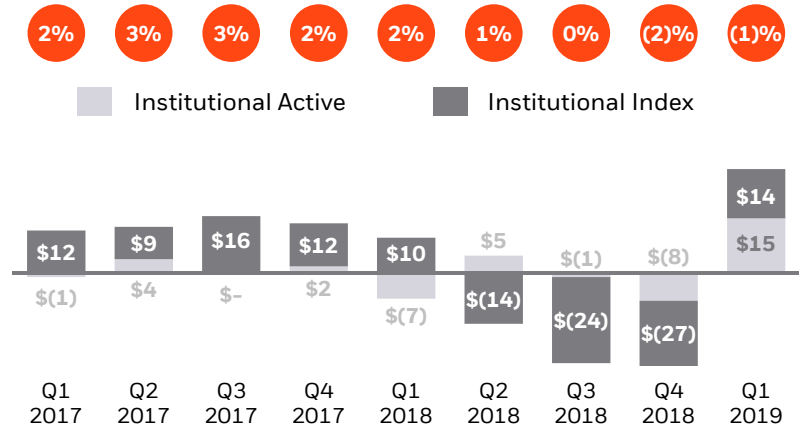

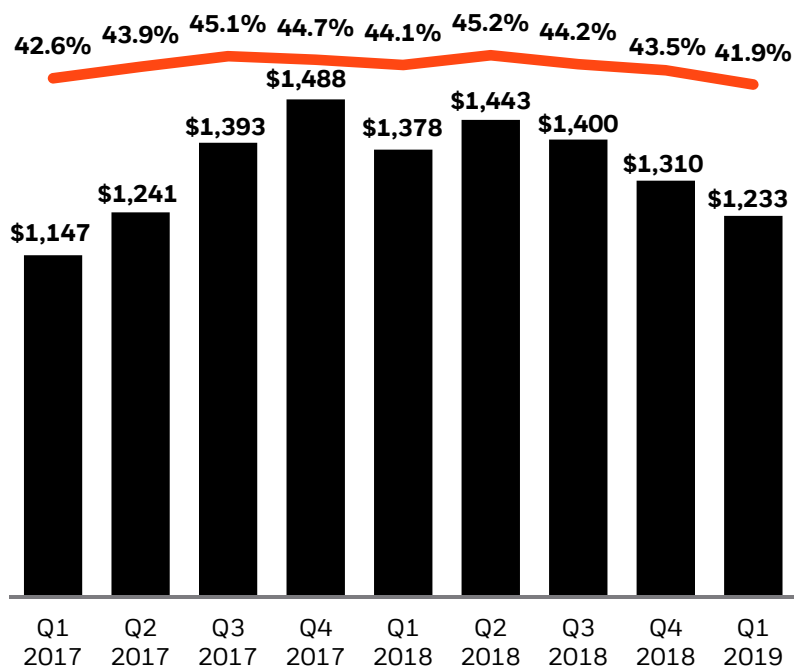
● LTM organic asset growth rate (%)      ● LTM organic base fee growth rate (%)

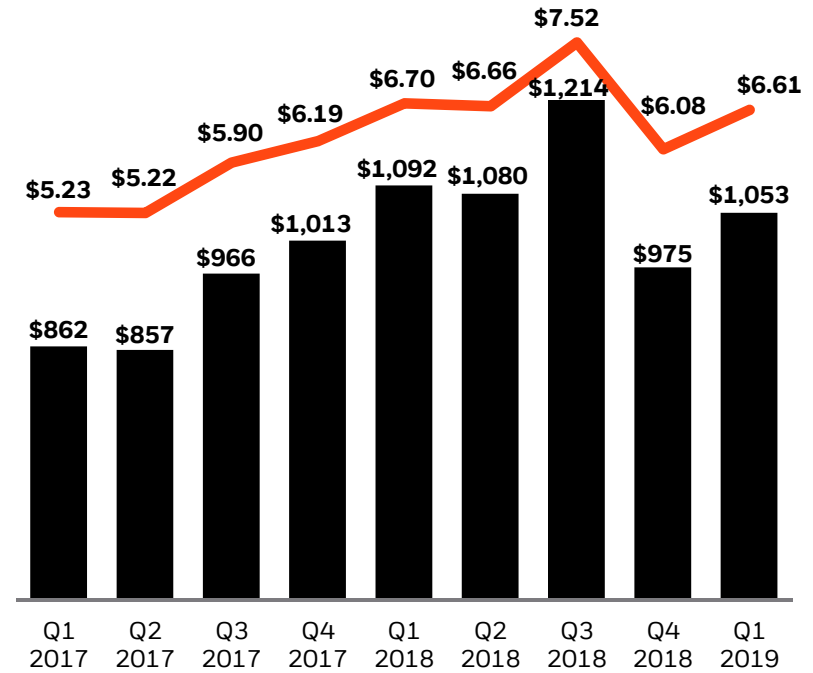

■ Net Income, as adjusted    — EPS, as adjusted

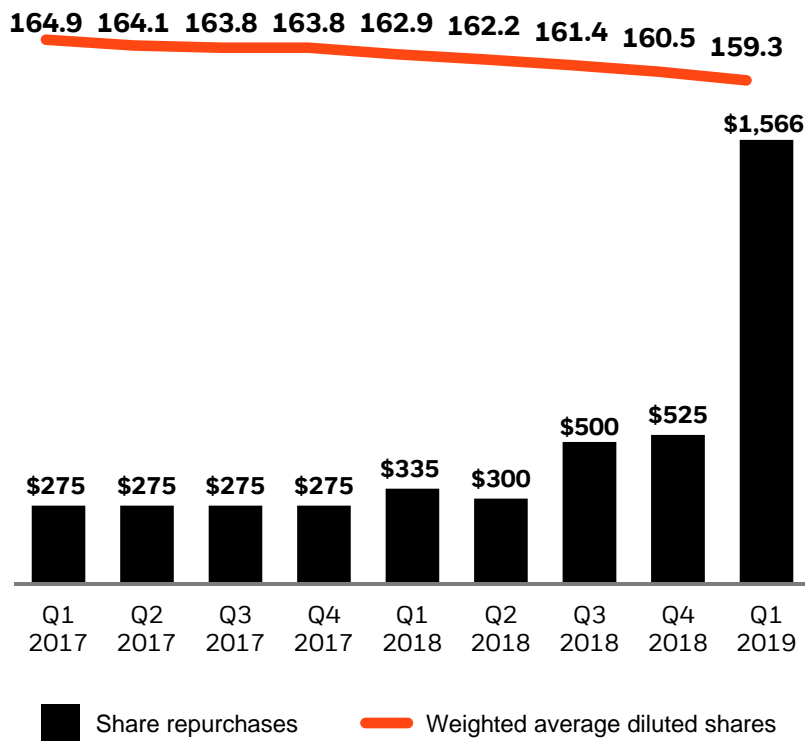

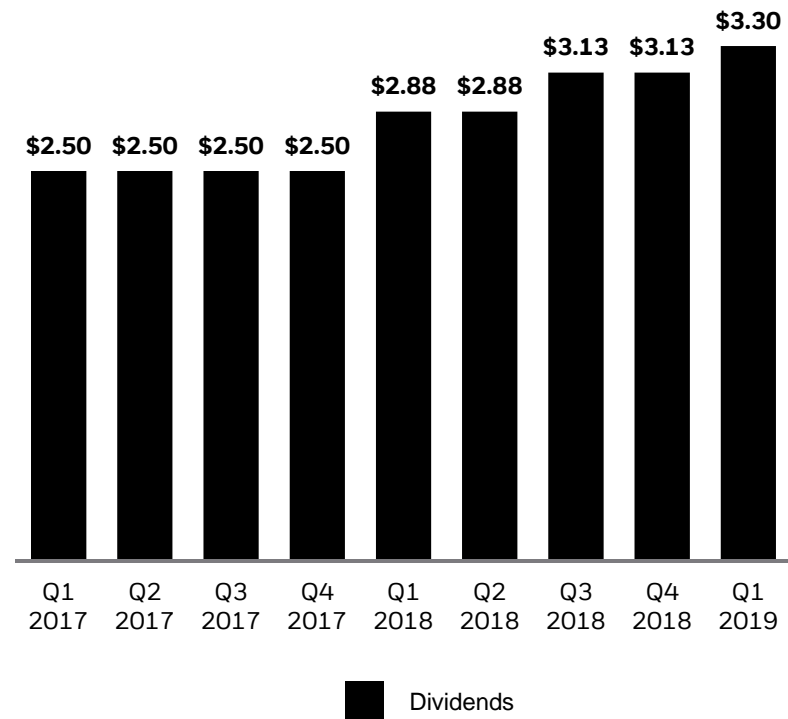

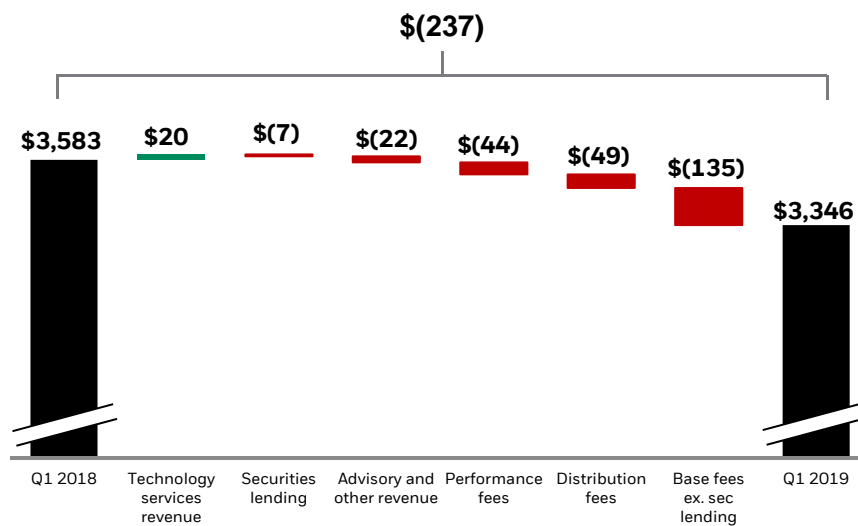

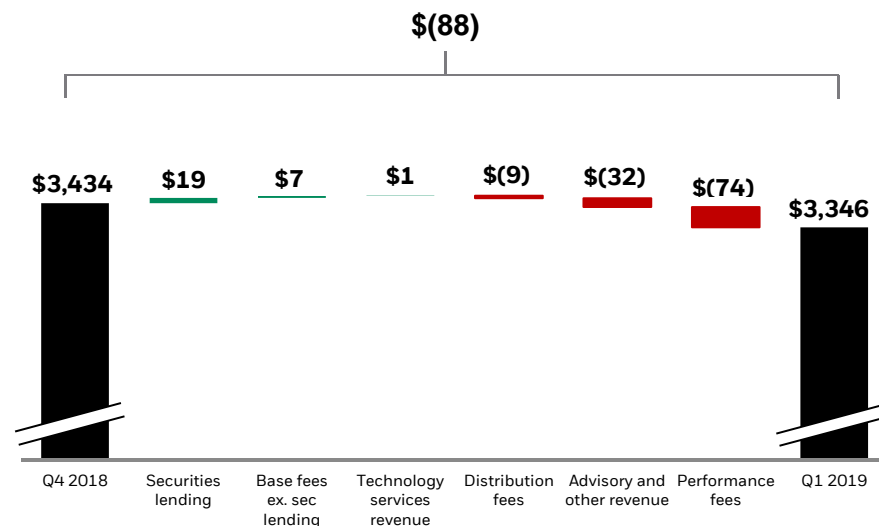

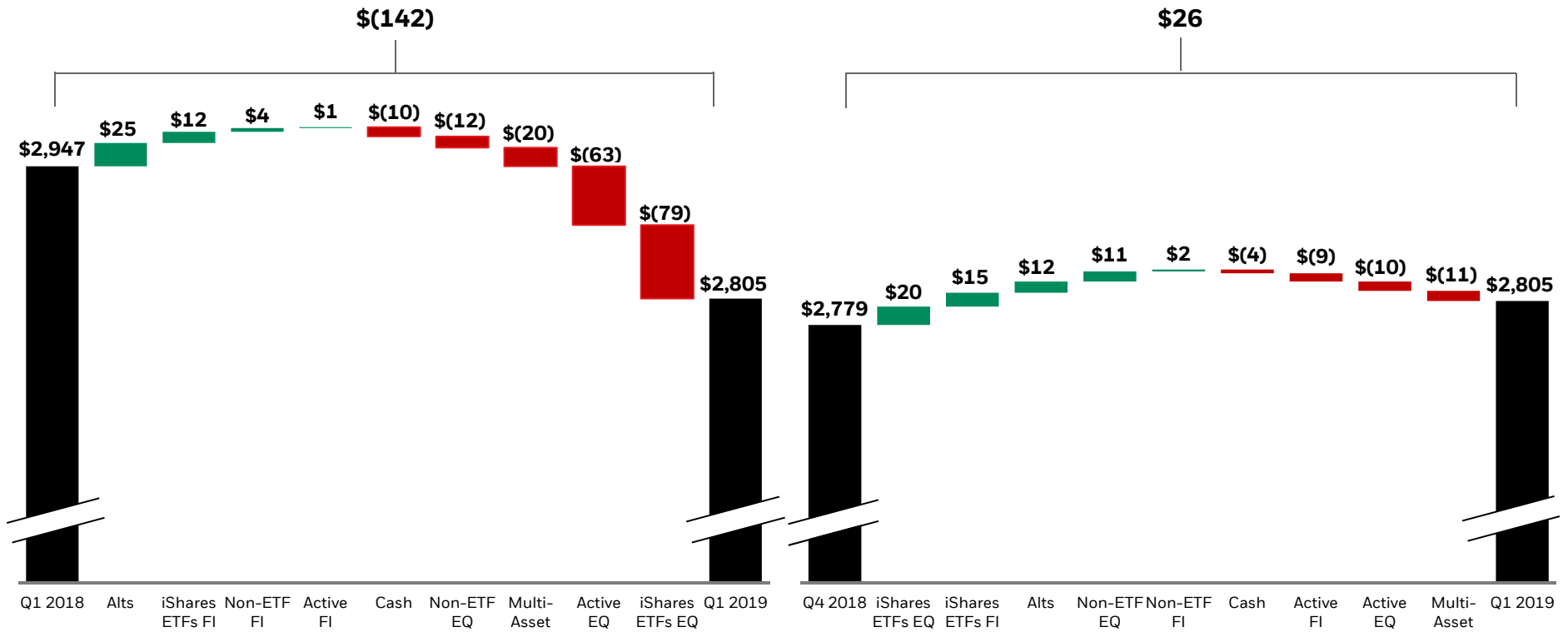


# Quarterly investment advisory, administration fees and securities lending revenue

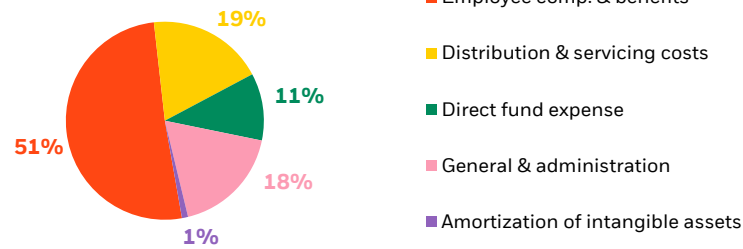

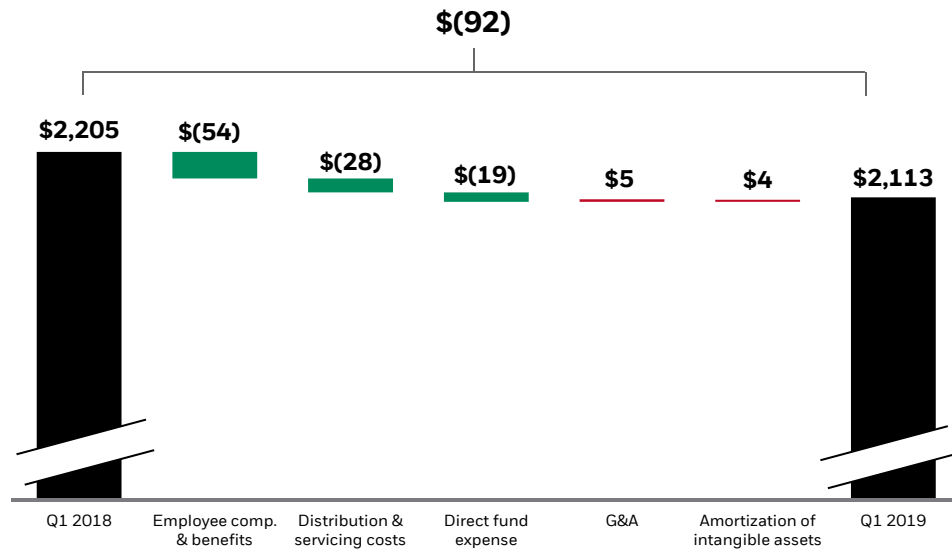

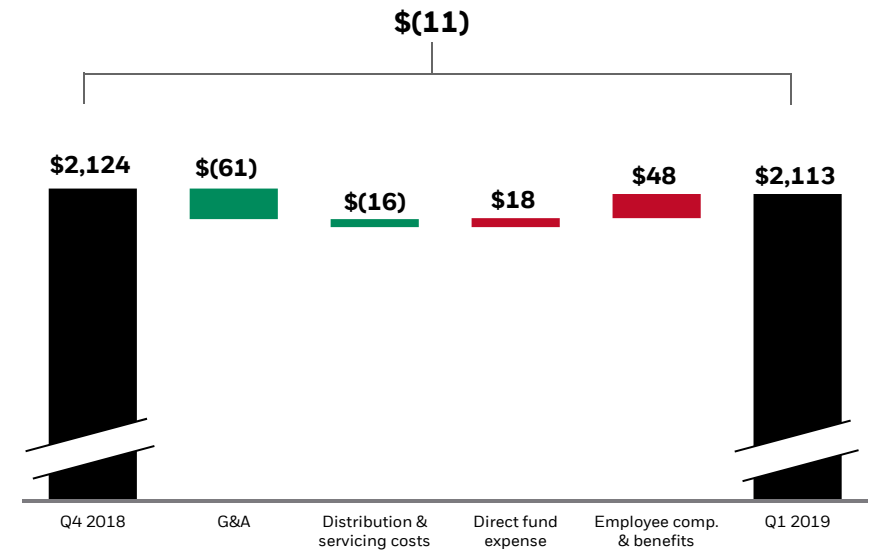
